The program will launch during the second six-week summer session, starting June 21st. The **application deadline is Monday, April 5th, 2021**. **BTU Scholarship** – Apply for one of ten BTU scholarships of \$500 each to graduating high school seniors who are interested in pursuing higher education at a college, university or trade

school. The application deadline is **April 2, 2021**. Considering the pandemic, the BTU Scholarship will not require SAT/ACT scores for this year's application. The parent(s), guardian(s) or grandparent(s) of the applicant must be a member of the Broward Teachers Union and the applicant must be graduating from an SBBC public school.

# 2021 Broward County Chiefs of Police Association Scholarship

Rules for the Broward County Chiefs of Police Association Scholarship Awards are as follows:

1. This is a one (1) year, \$1,500 Scholarship open to graduating high school seniors and currently enrolled college students who are pursuing degrees at an accredited university or college and is a dependent/sibling of an employee of a Broward County law enforcement agency.
2. The recipient must live in Broward County and be a dependent or immediate family of an employee of a Law Enforcement Agency within Broward County who is active, retired or vested.
3. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, G.P.A., and community involvement.
4. The selection of the applicants shall be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Broward County Chiefs of Police Association. All selections are final.
5. Applications must be submitted and postmarked to Dean Linda Wood c/o Broward College, Institute of Public Safety, 3501 SW Davie Road, Davie, FL 33314 by no later than **March 19, 2021**.
6. The scholarship awardee is to fully understand that in accepting this scholarship that:
  - A. It must be his/her intention to complete college. The selected high school recipients must provide proof of acceptance into the college noted on the application. The selected college student will provide official transcripts, and if selected will show proof of registration for the upcoming semester.
  - B. All applicants must average and maintain 3.0 GPA throughout the scholarship period (official transcripts will be required).
  - C. If selected all required paperwork needed for verification is required to be **June 15, 2021**. Any paperwork not turned in by the due date will result in forfeiture of scholarship.
  - D. The scholarship will be terminated should the recipient not fulfill the above requirements.
  - E. Checks will be issued in the name of the college stated in the application by the applicant and forwarded to the appropriate address upon verification of documents provided by the recipient.
  - F. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient or awardee to inform the Scholarship Committee of the correct mailing address where check should be mailed.
  - G. The application must be typed.
