### Scholarship Data Guidelines:

#### This is the 2020-2021 Broward Graduation Senior Survey question:

Add Scholarships that you received and are planning on using. List the **TOTAL** value for the Scholarship. Example: if you are getting a scholarship for \$1000 for **4 years**, then your TOTAL value of the scholarship is \$4000. Do **NOT** include Bright Futures Scholarships here. There is a separate question for that scholarship. For the dollar amount, **enter the amount WITHOUT any commas or periods**. The correct way to enter sixteen thousand dollars is 16000.

#### Students should not include these:

- FAFSA- This is not a scholarship
- Bright Futures – The district will pull all Bright Futures data.
- Unused Scholarships \*\*

\*\*Example: Received an FSU scholarship but will be attending USF. Received NAVY scholarship but will be attending Broward College.

Scholarships students report in Naviance will automatically populate in their senior survey.

#### **Student Action:**

A student must change/update their Naviance account if they were awarded the scholarship or not.

Senior survey will close June 4<sup>th</sup>.
