We'll be celebrating you on April 30th at 9:30 a.m. Whether you're deciding to attend college, technical school, enlisting in the armed services or joining the workforce, you're invited.

We are planning a pep rally style celebration to include a table decorating contest, cheerleaders, DJ, dessert bar, photo booth, and a raffle for a microwave oven. Each senior will get a declaration card and announce their college decision. You can join in the fun if you've committed to your future and have completed the Senior Information Form.



Questions & Answers:

Q: How are students selected to participate in the “Senior Signing Day” ceremony?

A: Every senior who registers by the deadline, Friday, April 19th, will be recognized in the ceremony. Please register ASAP. This will allow the planning committee more time to plan the ceremony. The registration form is the Student Information Form you were asked to complete. Students can email forms to me at tywana.greene@browardschools.com.

Q: What if I haven’t decided on a school by the registration deadline?

A: If you have not decided on a school/program by the registration deadline, you should register for the school you are leaning towards. We know students may need more time to decide, but you are still committing to continuing your education after high school and that’s what we want to celebrate. You will be asked to identify a school/program when you register for the event.

Q: What will happen if my I change my school/program after the ceremony?

A: You can change your mind after the ceremony. We will not be informing school representatives that you will attend that school, so you don’t need to worry about declaring one school in the ceremony and making your final decision to another. The certificate you will sign during the ceremony will only state that you are committed to continuing your education after high school and you can take your certificates home with you after the ceremony.

Q: What is the appropriate attire for the ceremony?

A: We don’t expect students to purchase new clothing for this event but we are asking that students wear an item representing their school of choice, military branch, or new employer to show off their decision.

The Broward County School district also wants to promote and celebrate our students. The plan is to collect videos of you stating your plans after graduation. Please wear or display any gear you have for your after-graduation choice. Please submit videos by April 21. You can submit/forward everything to me.
